## ABOUT THE SPEAKERS

From atheist to protestant minister, **Howard Storm** died in a Paris hospital and descended into Hell twenty five years ago. After a simple prayer Jesus lifted him out of the darkness into the light of heaven where he watched a riveting review of his life. In his bestselling book, "My Descent into Death," Author Anne Rice wrote, "The story is beyond remarkable. Hell and Heaven are realized in these pages."

Corporate CEO **John Rick Miller** experienced financial prosperity but his life of luxury took a dramatic turn following a massive spiritual conversion in 1988 through Our Lady Queen of Peace. He subsequently surrendered his life to God and today, he is leading what is now the largest and one of the fastest growing Catholic missions in the world, "For the Love of God Worldwide." In 2008, Miller engineered the consecration of Colombia to the Sorrowful and Immaculate heart of Mary and the Sacred heart of Jesus.

Catholic Theologian, author and widow, **Judy Klein** spent 20 years praying for her husband's spiritual conversion. Her prayers were answered when he died and had an illumination of his soul where he saw his sins through the eyes of God. Through the intercession of the Blessed Mother, Bernie Klein was allowed to return to life to make amends before crossing over one last time. Judy says her husband's powerful experience is rooted in theology and was a gift of grace that demonstrates the lengths that God will go to save us.

Award winning broadcast journalist, **Mary Lou McCall** underwent a life changing conversion in 1986, while reporting on the Miracles in Medjugorje. Her conversion is linked to a prophetic childhood vision of Jesus. Twenty years later, following a successful spiritual TV ministry, a demonic darkness enveloped Mary Lou's life and she nearly died of alcoholism. Her remarkable story of recovery and redemption, gives powerful witness to the gifts of the sacraments, especially the Holy Eucharist.
